What we do...



Kitchen cabinetry in particular gets a lot of wear and tear. Water damage to a sink base cabinet is the main reason for replacing. Over time, leaking pipes and even just

with typical use, a sink base cabinet can be destroyed, also often causing growth of toxic mold and mildew.. Sometimes just with normal use, wood can crack and paint can chip and peel. Particle board, laminates and vinyl materials can fall apart, degrade and discolor.

Despite today's importance on the environment, still many building materials such as used cabinets are discarded in landfills and dumpsters.

We acquire previously owned kitchen and bath cabinetry from business partners, and other sources to improve them for others to buy second hand.

We firmly believe that reusing and recycling is extremely important and responsible.

We find that many people like ourselves believe in our mission and can't afford new, highly priced kitchens. Alternately, in fact, their purpose may even be to put in a temporary solution until they or future owners can replace with what they prefer.

We make our inventory available through various sales venues and price it competitively so we can acquire new stock frequently.

If we don't have what you need at the time, we will often be able to contact you later with the items you were looking for.

How we do it...

Once we acquire previously owned items, we repair, match, replace, paint, stain, and in any way we can affordably do it, restore items to good or better condition. We price our refurbished items competitively so that we can keep inventory moving. After all, there are many more cabinets to save! 😊

What you should or can do...

If you or someone you know is looking for cabinetry, there are a few things you can do to prepare.



Decide- What layout are you interested in for your project.? Are you replacing one piece or adding pieces? Are you replacing in kind? If not, you will need to decide what changes you want to make. Will you have a "U" or horseshoe shaped kitchen, a single strip, a galley (cabinets on both sides), or an "L" shaped kitchen? It may be helpful to take pictures of your existing cabinetry. It also can be very useful to have a written plan of the future layout.

Measure- Figure out the sizes of the cabinets you will need. There are many sizes available but only you can know your preferences and what will be functional for you. If you need help with this, please feel free to call or email for tips.



Contact- Let us know what listing you are interested in or if you haven't found what you're looking for yet, give us measurements, drawings and or pictures of what you're looking for. We'll do our best to help find what you need and want.

Bring- If you are picking up, be prepared with the right equipment. You will need a truck, trailer or other vehicle that will accommodate the cabinetry you are going to transport. Occasionally we can deliver for a small fee. Ideally, ratchet-type straps are best as they are adjustable and secure with a locking feature. Bungee cords can be helpful but we don't recommend relying on them to secure a load of cabinets.



Payment- Please agree on a form of payment prior to the time of picking up your cabinetry.

Follow up- Please send us pictures when you're done with your project so others can see the value in reusing and recycling!
